

2026 LINDENHURST ST. PATRICK'S PARADE

Frequently Asked Questions

Which date in March is the Lindenhurst St. Patrick's Parade held?

The Lindenhurst St. Patrick's Parade will be held on Saturday, March 21st, 2026. (Raindate: March 28th, 2026)

At what time does the Parade start and end?

The Parade will step off promptly at 12:00 P.M. EST. It ends at approximately 2:00 P.M.

Where does the Parade begin and end?

The Parade begins at Fireman's Park on Heling Boulevard. It will travel west on Hartford Street, turn south on Wellwood Avenue, and officially end on South Wellwood Avenue at Gates Avenue. Marchers will continue to the Lindenhurst Middle School for safe dismissal.

Where is the best location to stand when attending the Lindenhurst St. Patrick's Parade?

What time should I get there?

Anywhere along Wellwood Avenue – between Hartford Street and Gates Avenue -- will give spectators a fine location to experience the Parade. The Grandstand will be located near Village Square Park, on the North East side of the Wellwood-Hoffman intersection (facing west). So, if you prefer to stand as close to the Grandstand as possible, then the earlier you get there, the better.

As a spectator, what time should I arrive to attend the Parade?

Spectators can begin lining up along Wellwood Avenue as early as they would like. "Best views to those who show up early."

Will the Parade be canceled due to bad weather?

We will decide the morning of the parade, but we are likely to continue with the parade unless it is unsafe.

Are there portable restrooms set up along the Parade route?

There will be portable restrooms located at the start of the parade route, near Village Square Park, and at the end of the parade route outside the Lindenhurst Middle School.

Where is the Grandstand?

The Grandstand will be located near Village Square Park, on the North East side of the Wellwood Avenue-Hoffman Avenue intersection (facing west).

Can I bring my kids to the Parade?

Our parade is for the whole family; young and old are welcome to enjoy the day with us! Volunteers from the Lindenhurst Youth Center will be walking the parade route prior to step-off to hand out free giveaways to everyone who is young at heart!

How should I dress for the Parade?

Formal wear is not required, but please feel free to dress up if you would like. If you prefer to dress less formally, consider slacks, skirts, shirts with collars, closed-toe shoes, tie with no jacket. Also consider what not to wear: large hats, beads, etc.

Are Parade marchers permitted to march with their children in strollers?

Yes, parents may march with their children in strollers.

Are service dogs allowed to march with their owners?

Yes.

What streets will be closed during the Parade?

Starting at approximately 10:00 AM, the following intersections will be barricaded:

Byrd Street (between Irmisch & West Side One-Way of Heling & between East Side of One-Way of Heling & North Alleghany – for safe Drop Off Zone for marchers)

Hartford Street (Wellwood to Irmisch)

Irmisch Avenue (Dover to Hartford)

Charles Street (Hartford to Alleghany)

N. Alleghany (Charles to Byrd)

N. Wellwood (Hoffman to John)

S. Wellwood Ave at Reade Avenue

S. Wellwood Ave at Gates Avenue

Wellwood Ave & Hoffman Avenue (between First Street & High Street)

N. Wellwood Ave at Auburn Street

N. Wellwood Ave at Bristol Street

N. Wellwood Ave at John Street

N. Wellwood at Dover Street

N. Wellwood at Easton Street

N. Wellwood at Fremont Street

N. Wellwood at Harrington Avenue

N. Wellwood Ave at Gary Street

N. Wellwood Ave at Dekalb Avenue
